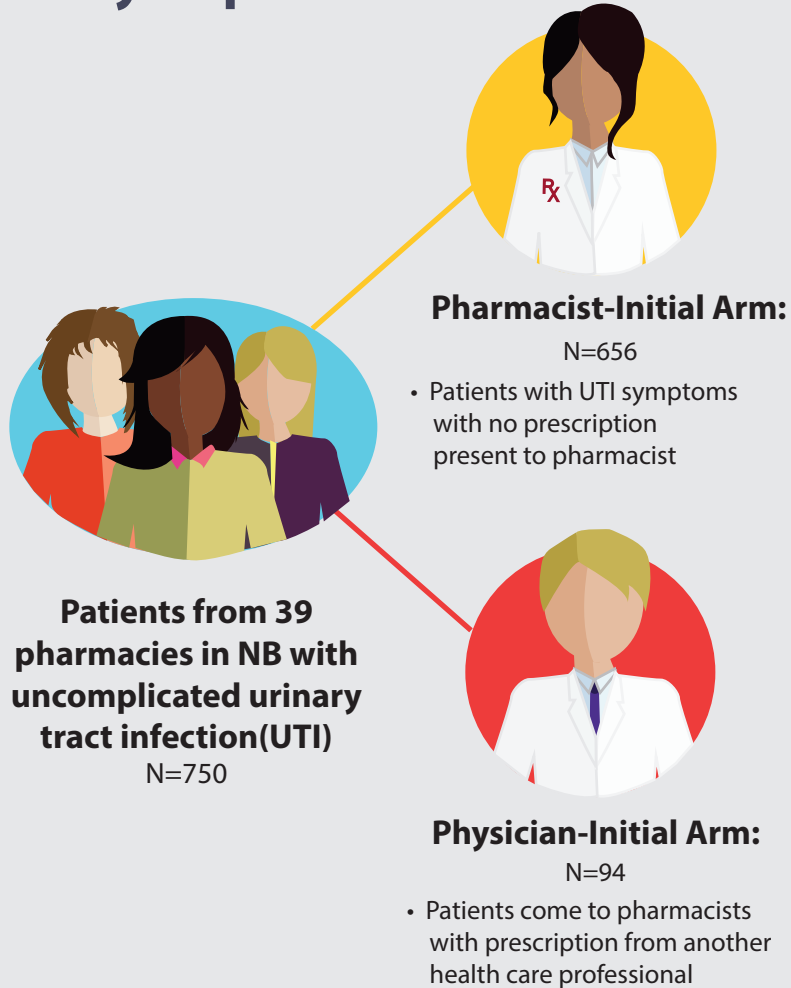


## Study Population:



## Pharmacist's Interventions:



**Assessment for UTI Symptoms**



**Prescribed antibacterial therapy**



**Provided education**

OR



**Referred to a physician where appropriate**



**Assessed and modified prescription where appropriate**

## Outcomes:

**Pharmacist-Initial** arm had a sustained **clinical cure rate of 88.9%**

**Patients' satisfaction very high:**

- quality of care received
- accessibility
- trust
- support pharmacists role

**Management** of uncomplicated **UTI by pharmacists is effective and safe** and **patients** express a **high level of satisfaction** with this care.

**Public funding** would improve **access** to this service
