


Outcomes of Urinary Tract Infection Management by Pharmacists: R_xOUTMAP Study



Pharmacist's Interventions:



Assessment for UTI Symptoms



Prescribed antibacterial therapy



Provided education

OR



Referred to a physician where appropriate



Assessed and modified prescription where appropriate

Outcomes:

Pharmacist-Initial arm had a sustained clinical cure rate of 88.9%

Patients 'satisfaction very high:

- quality of care received
- accessibility
- trust
- support pharmacists role

Management of uncomplicated UTI by pharmacists is effective and safe and patients express a high level of satisfaction with this care.

Public funding would improve access to this service
