

# A patient's journey with Hepatitis C



## Testing

You decide to get tested as part of the study.\* We won't tell anyone about your testing and care unless you want them to know.



You go to a pharmacy or agency doing testing



If you test negative, you'll learn how to keep from getting the virus.

## Treatment

If you test positive, you may need to go to another pharmacy. A pharmacist with extra training will work with you to decide the best next steps for you.\*



If it makes sense for you, the pharmacist will prescribe the Hep C medicine for you. You'll get either Maviret or Epclusa.\* It takes 8 to 12 weeks to treat Hep C.



12 weeks (3 months) after you're done the medicine, you'll be tested again.\*\* if the pharmacist finds no signs of the virus, you're cured. You'll learn how to keep safe in the future.



- Bring a friend at any point in the journey to be tested and get a gift.
- If you have health/care worker and want them to know, let us know.



End goal is to cure the virus

If you aren't cured, a pharmacist will refer you to a liver clinic, for further follow-up.
